Ballenger Creek, Brunswick, Centerville, Emmitsburg, Glade, Green Valley, Hillcrest, Lewistown, Liberty, Middletown Primary, Lincoln, Monocacy, Monocacy Montessori, New Market, New Midway/Woodsboro, North Frederick, Orchard Grove, Parkway, Sabillasville, Spring Ridge, Thurmont Primary, Tuscarora, Twin Ridge, Urbana, Valley, Walkersville, Waverly, Whittier, and Wolfsville have full day Kindergarten classes and therefore are counted as full time students.

Note 2: Middletown ES and Thurmont ES are grades 3, 4 and 5 only. Middletown Primary and Thurmont PS are PK, K, 1 and 2 only.

Note 3: The Monocacy Montessori School is located in the former First Baptist Church located on Dill Ave. in Frederick City. It's capacity is based on program limitations
